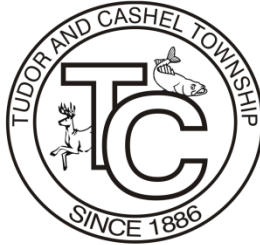

**Starting Immediately** – Cash will no longer be accepted at the waste site. All Fees for the waste site such as bulky waste and bag tags will be **invoiced at the waste site and paid through office**, we have made several payment options available. Be prepared to show identification with your current and correct mailing address. Invoices not paid after 30 days will be added to your tax account.

Bag tags are now mandatory for household waste – we encourage you to recycle as much as possible

For non-emergency events with **NO** injuries, **NO** suspects and **NO** evidence such as theft under \$5,000, stolen license plates, mischief/damage to vehicle or property, driving complaints or missing property you can report it online. Go to [opp.ca/reporting](http://opp.ca/reporting) Choose your location and start your report, an automatic report number will be provided once complete and **IF REQUIRED**, an officer will contact you in 72 hours.
